Please be advised that as of 8/1/2020 Disconnect Policies and Service Fees Resume.

Base Rate Increase of \$1.00 effective 7/1/2020.

Basic Water Service is now \$63.00 per month for up to 25,000 gallons; each additional 1,000 gallons is \$3.00.

Please make sure that you are aware of the location of your customer shut-off valve. If not you can call the office during business hours @775-629-0849 and we will send a friendly staff member out to show you. If you have a Customer Shut-off Valve and call a Technician out after hours or on the weekend you will incur an after hours Call Out Fee on your bill.

Summer is HERE!!– Please remember to water your plants, flowers and trees early in the day when it is cool and not windy. This will allow them to absorb the water better. Also, be sure to walk your drip line and check for leaks, sometimes the little critters that call Stagecoach home can do damage to them.
