Please make sure you are checking your cooler floats, as a stuck cooler float could waste as much water during the summer months as a broken pipe in the WINTER.

Please make sure that you are aware of the location of your customer shut-off valve. If not, please call the office @ 775-629-0849 and we will send Joe or Steven out to show you. If you have a customer shut-off valve and call one of the technicians out after hours or on the weekend you will incur an after-hours call out fee on your bill.

Planting trees, bushes and flowers that are native to our area can help reduce water consumption and the long-term cost of maintenance.
